Code of Conduct for Parents/Supporters

This Code applies to all Parents/Supporters attending Training Sessions and Football Matches involving Cockermouth Junior Football Club in any league or game.

It is the responsibility of the club to encourage parents/spectators to:

- Applaud the opposition as well as your own team.
- Avoid coaching your child during the game.
- Refrain from shouting or using inappropriate language.
- Respect and accept the decisions of the Match Officials.
- Give attention to each of the children involved in football, not just the most talented.
- Give encouragement to everyone to participate in football.
- Be positive and encouraging to all of the children, not just their own.
- Remain behind any physical barrier (Fence/Line of Cones) during the match and must not encroach within 1 metre of the touchline or stand behind either goal.
- Parents/guardians must not leave their children unattended while waiting for Coaches at the start of training sessions/matches and must be present to collect their children at the end of training sessions and matches.

Code of Conduct for Team Officials

This Code applies to all team coaches/managers/club officials.

Obligations towards the game

A Team Official should:

- Set a positive example for others, particularly young players and supporters.
- Promote and develop his own team having regard to the interest of the players and supporters.
- Share knowledge and experience when invited to do so, taking into account the interest of the body that has requested this, rather than personal interests.
- Avoid all forms of gamesmanship.
- Show due respect to Match Officials and others involved in the game.
- Always have high regard to the best interests of the game including when publicly expressing an opinion on the game and any particular aspect of it, including others involved in the game.
- Not use inappropriate language.

Obligations Towards the Team

A Team Official should:

- Make every effort to develop the sporting, technical and tactical levels of the team, and to obtain the best results by the team, using all permitted means.
- Give priority to the interests of the team over individual interests.
- Resist all illegal or unsporting influences, including banned substances and techniques.
- Promote ethical principles.
- Show due respect to the interests of players, coaches and other officials, at their own club/team and others.

Respect towards the Match Officials

A Team Official should:

- Accept the decision of the Match Officials without protest.
- Avoid words or actions which may mislead a Match Official.
- Show due respect towards Match Officials.

Obligation Towards the Supporters

A Team Official should:

- Show due respect to the interests of Supporters.

Players Code of Conduct

Players are the most important people in the sport. Playing for the team, and for the team to win, is the most fundamental part of the game, but not winning at any cost. Fair play and respect for all others in the game is fundamentally important.

Obligations towards the game

A Player should:

- Make every effort to develop their own sporting abilities in terms of skill, technique, tactics and stamina.
- Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance during a game, even if his team is in a position where the desired result has already been achieved.
- Set a positive example for others, particularly young players and supporters.
- Avoid all forms of gamesmanship, and time wasting.
- Always have high regard to the best interests of the game including where publicly expressing an opinion on the game and any particular aspect of it, including others involved in the game.
- Not use inappropriate language.

Obligations towards One's Own Team

A Player should:

- Make every effort consistent with Fair Play and the Laws of the Game to help his own team win.
- Resist any influence which might, or might be seen to, bring into question his commitment to the team winning.

Respect for the Laws of the Game and Competition Rules

A Player should:

- Know and abide by the laws, rules and spirit of the game, and the competition rules.
- Accept success and failure, victory and defeat equally.

Respect towards opponents

A Player should:

- Treat opponents with due respect at all times, irrespective of the results of the game.
- Safeguard the physical fitness of opponents, avoid violence and rough play, and help injured opponents.

Respect towards the Match Officials

A Player should:

- Accept the decision of the Match Officials without protest.
- Avoid words or actions which may mislead a Match Official.
- Show due respect towards Match Officials.

Respect towards Team Officials

A Player should:

- Abide by the instructions of their coach and Team Officials, provided they do not contradict the spirit of this code.
- Show due respect towards the Team Officials of the opposition.

Obligation Towards the Supporters

A Player should:

- Show due respect to the interests of Supporters
